

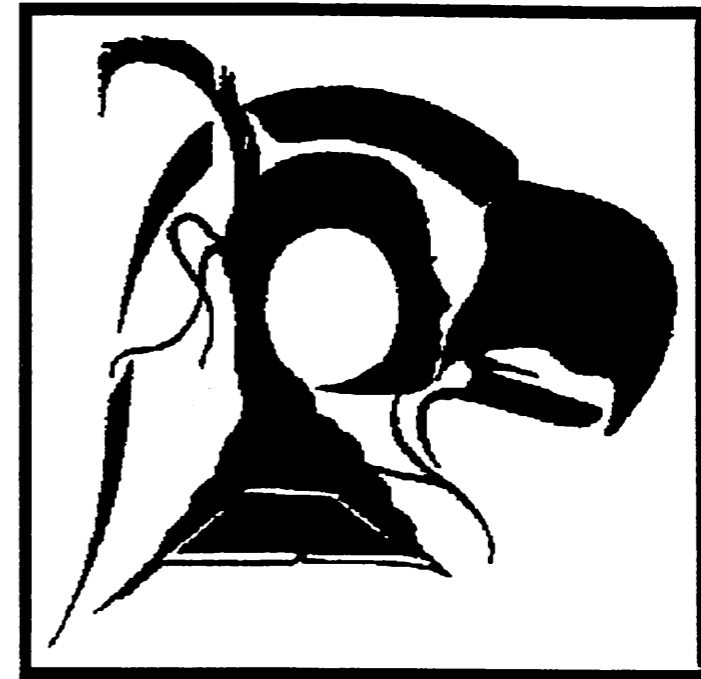
# WELCOME TO THE SEABIRD ISLAND 28TH ANNUAL FESTIVAL

Seabird Island 28th Annual Festival War Canoe Races May 24, & 25 - 1997

## Rules and Regulations

1. No jumping out of canoe, ie. if you leave with 11 men you return with 11 men.
2. Each canoe is required to hang on to the starting rope with the remaining paddles in an upward position.
3. No missing turns.
4. No paddle swinging.
5. No hanging on the opponent.
6. Complaints must be brought in by the Skipper(s) only.
7. Dug out canoes only, No fiberglass or laminated canoes.
8. Judges decision is final.

- ☐ This year Sundays schedule will follow Saturday's format.
- ☐ May 24th the captains draw for positions at 12:00 P.M. and the races to follow.
- ☐ May 25th the captains draw for positions at 11:00 A.M. and the races to follow.
- ☐ 4 man Paddle is scheduled for Saturday with the 6 man on Sunday.  
The 4 Man Paddle was one of the main events on Seabird up to the 1950's.
- ☐ Prizes to be picked up after each race by the skipper(s) only.
- ☐ Travel monies for Canoes outside of this area will be paid on Sunday after the races.
- ☐ As in the past few years, we will again recognize the most sportsman like canoe with a trophy. Keep in mind the importance of fair play among the canoe clubs.

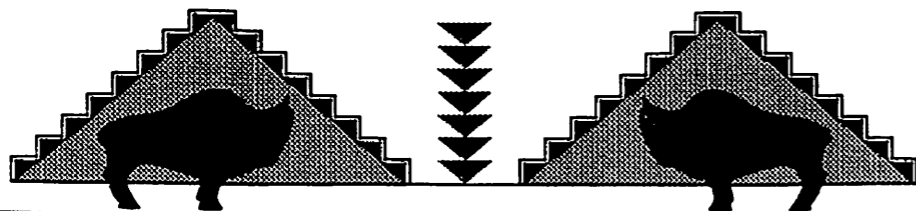
