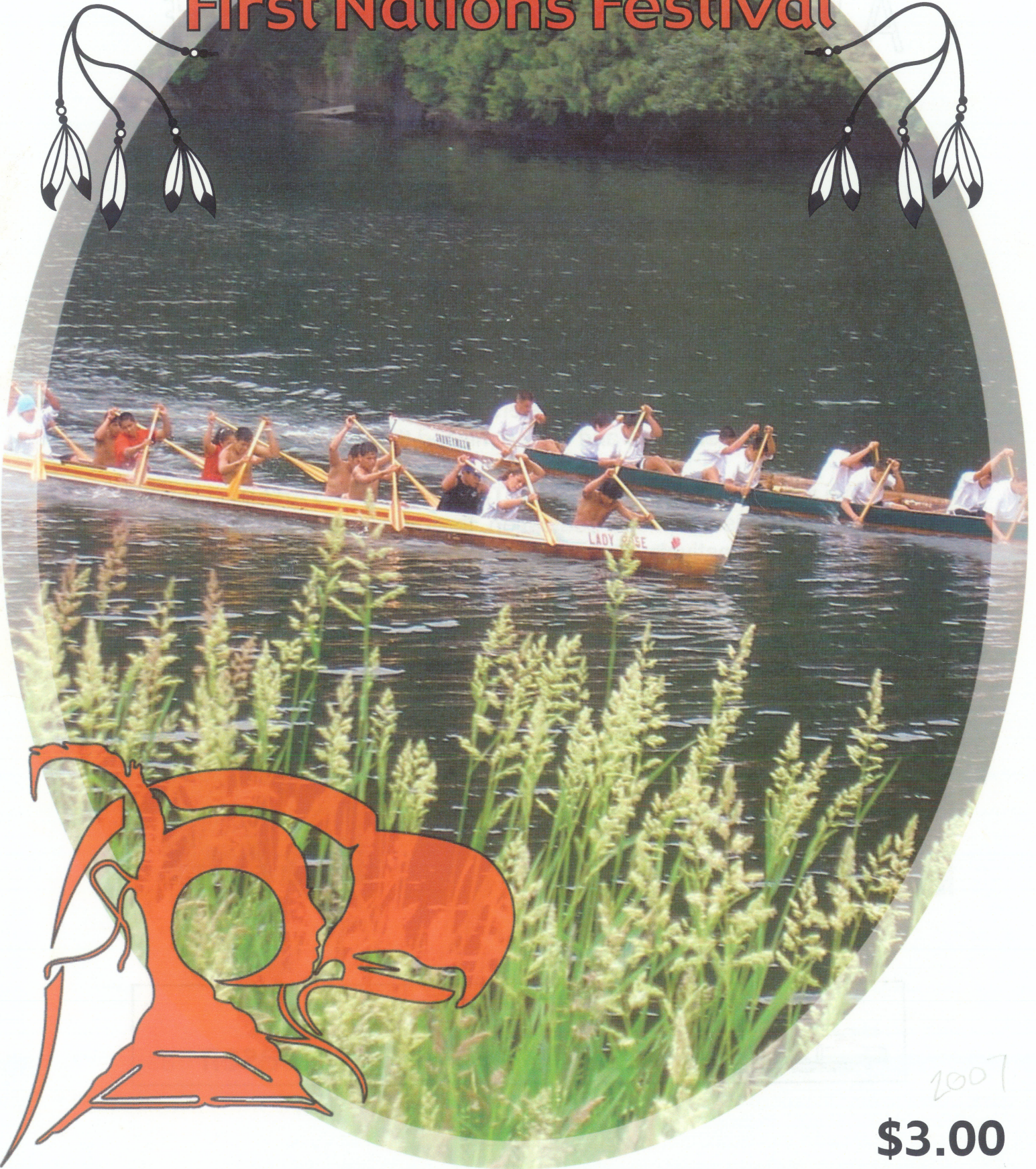


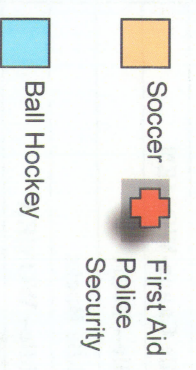
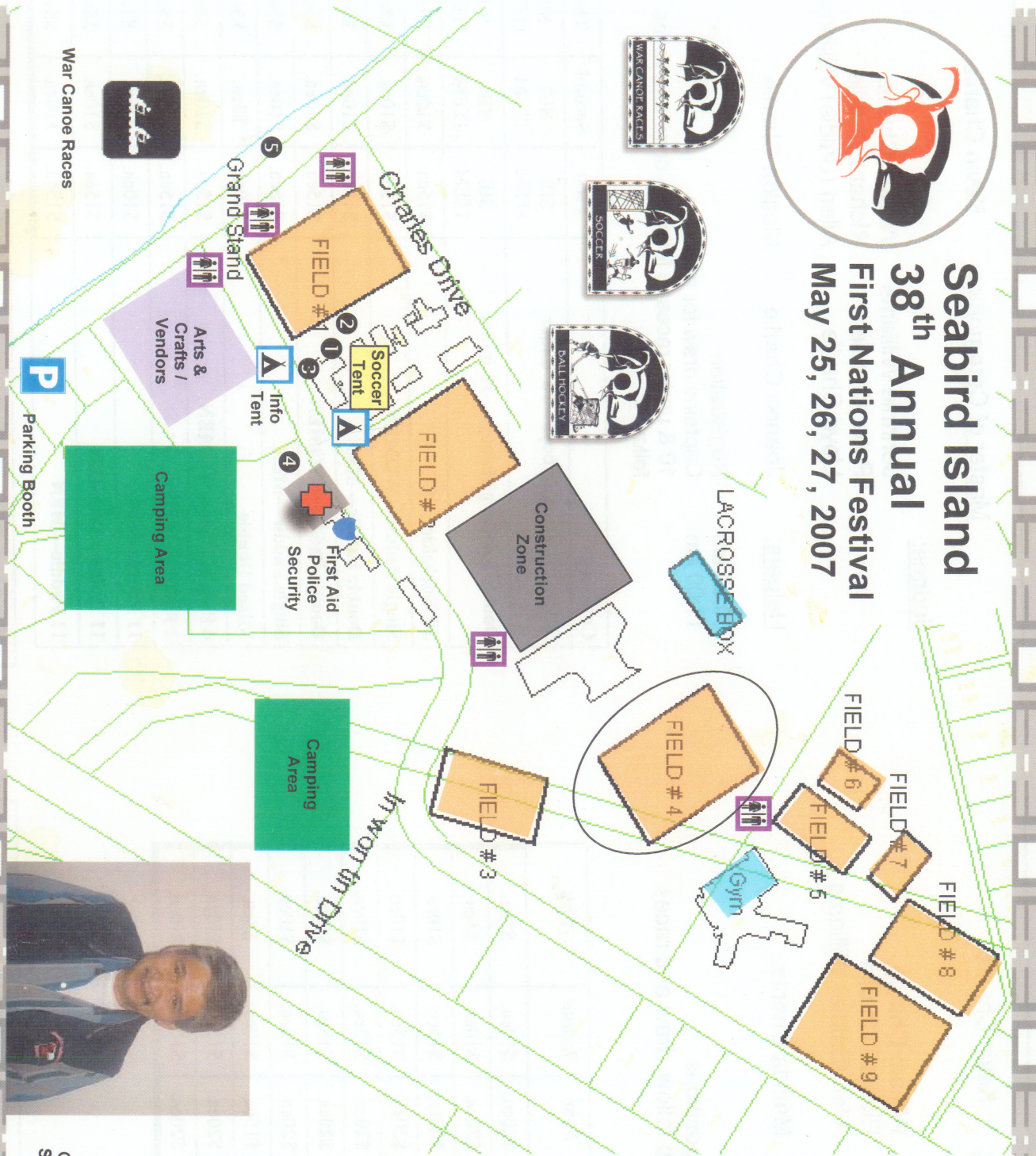

A Message from the Chief

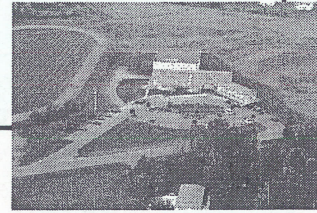
The Seabird Island Chief and Council and Band Members, would like to welcome everyone to the 38th Annual Seabird Island Festival.
